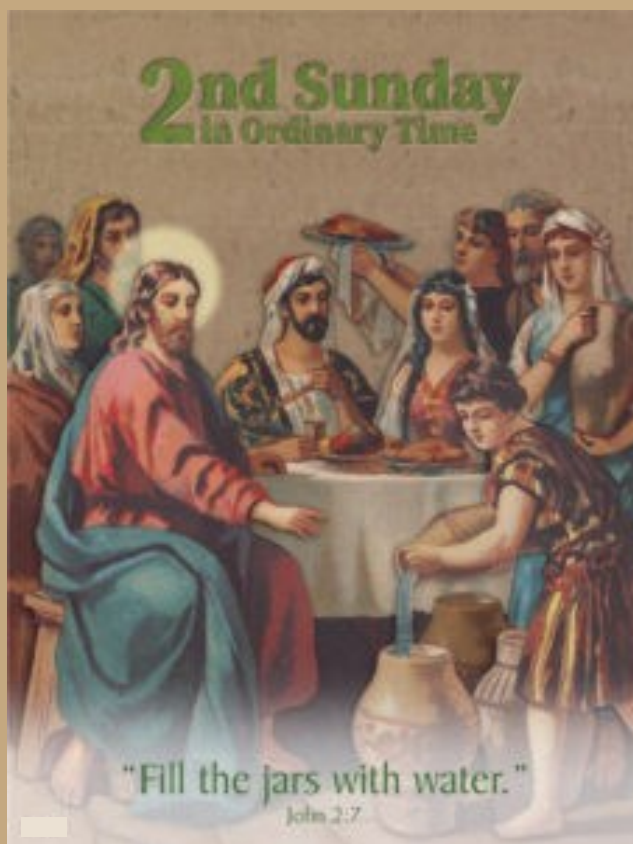

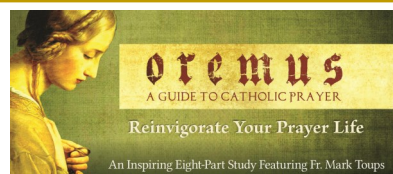

nor partiality influence our actions.

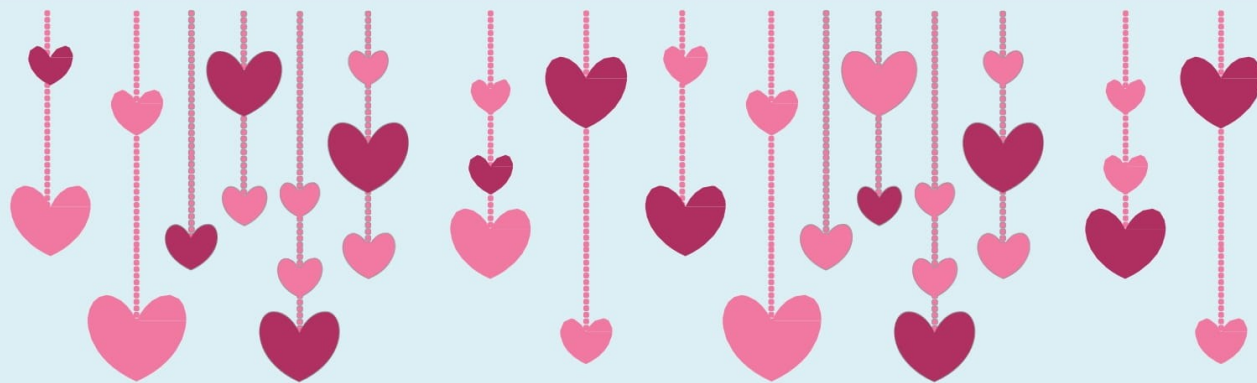
Let us find in You our unity
